

## DIRECTIONS TO QUAIL ROOST FARM

From Interstate 85, exit onto  
North Duke Street(Hwy 501N)

Travel 12.6 miles & you will  
see large tan sign with farm  
name, 3 board wooden fenc-  
ing, tan barns and silos. Turn  
left at light onto Quail Roost  
Farm Rd.

Proceed past vet clinic and at  
the end of long shedrow  
building with porch, turn right  
at the "school barn"  
sign. Follow the gravel road  
between the riding ring and  
pasture. Please drive slowly  
and watch out for horses and  
children!
